

Ring of Benavir Nine-Fingers

This ring is obviously of great value as it is made from pure platinum and has ten star sapphires set into the band. A single tiny symbol is engraved between each of the gems which is the clan sigil of the Du Chagne family.

This ring began as the coming of age gift for young Benavir du Chagne, merchant prince of the house of Du Chagne of Tarsis. Benavir was a young wizard who excelled at creating masterful illusions and created many of the illusion spells that wizards use today. He would eventually rise to become head of the order of red robes. At the height of his power he enhanced his family ring with many enchantments and as much magical energy as he could.

When worn, the ring enhances all illusions cast by the bearer, granting a +1 DC to these spells and increases the caster level of all illusions cast by 1 as well.

If the bearer happens to be an illusionist, then they may cast all illusions as if affected by the silent spell and still spell feats with no increase in casting time or cost in spell level. The ring also grants one bonus illusion spell per level of spell that the illusionist can cast each day.

Unlocking each ability requires a Knowledge: History or Knowledge: Arcana check with a DC of 30 that can be attempted once per month. The abilities are revealed randomly.
